Your application for the following laboratory has been approved by the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) to test industrial hemp for tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) concentration:

The following standard operating procedures have been approved for testing THC concentration, using high performance liquid chromatography coupled with ultraviolet detector:

- MF-CHEM-31 (Version 1.4 – October 13, 2021)

Section 4943(f) in Title 3 of the California Code of Regulations requires that any changes to the laboratory's standard operating procedures must be submitted to the Department for review and approval prior to implementation.

Please note that the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) recently amended federal hemp regulations through a final rule, published on January 15, 2021, and took effect on March 22, 2021. CDFA is reviewing the final rule to determine the impacts on the program and may amend state regulations to ensure continued compliance. CDFA will notify you if any amendments to state regulations will require changes to your standard operating procedures to maintain your laboratory approval.
