Subject: Approval of Laboratory Certification for Hemp-Derived Cannabinoid Testing

The Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission (TABC) has completed its review of your application for certification as a laboratory authorized to conduct testing of hemp-derived cannabinoid (HDC) products in the State of Tennessee. Your application has been reviewed for scientific sufficiency, ownership disclosure, and compliance acknowledgments. Based on the documentation provided, the TABC hereby approves your application.

Your laboratory is now officially recognized as an Approved Laboratory under the Commission's regulatory program. This designation authorizes you to issue Certificates of Analysis (COAs) for HDC products intended for sale in Tennessee, subject to continued compliance with all applicable statutes, rules, and guidance documents.

Please note the following:

- This approval remains valid for two (2) years from the approval effective date, January 1, 2026. TABC recommends reapplying at least 45 days prior to the expiration date to ensure continuity of approval.
- You must notify the TABC of any material changes to your application or operations, including ownership structure, accreditation status, changes in COA format, or testing capabilities, within thirty (30) days.
- You may be asked to participate in periodic proficiency testing.
- Failure to comply with applicable rules may result in revocation of this approval and invalidation of any COAs issued.
